To convert a photo to a PDF on an iPhone, you can use the Files app or the Notes app.

Using the Files app

1. Open the Files app
2. Find the image you want to convert
3. Press and hold on the image
4. Select Quick Actions
5. Select Create PDF

Using the Notes app

1. Open the Notes app
2. Select New Note
3. Select the camera icon
4. Select Scan Documents
5. Position the camera over the document
6. The camera will automatically take a picture and scan it into a PDF

To convert a photo to a PDF on an Android device, you can use the Gallery or Photos app to print the photo and then select Save as PDF.

Steps

1. Open the photo you want to convert in the Gallery or Photos app
2. Click the three dots icon to access more options
3. Select Print
4. In the Printer Options, **select Save as PDF**
6. Choose your preferred location for your PDF and press Save
7. Use this file to send as PDF via email
